



Heat the bird, not the outdoors this Thanksgiving

Now is the time to prepare your home for winter. Challenge yourself to keep as much heat in your home as possible. Here are some suggestions:

- Caulk or foam any perforation in finished walls and ceilings, especially under sinks, vanities and utility rooms and any other plumbing
- Seal all duct register boots to the sub-floor or wall they go through
- Weatherstrip and insulate attic portals
- Weatherstrip, insulate and seal crawlspace access doors
- Seal around all holes in the attic floor created by plumbing and wiring, also caulk along top plates of the walls below
- Wash dirt and debris from the coils of the outdoor unit of a heat pump (turn off electricity first)
- Change filters in furnaces and air-handlers on a regular basis
- Caulk or foam all perforations in the floor above of any crawlspace or un-conditioned basement
- Seal cracks in foundation and crawlspace walls
