

When asked what he most enjoys about working on Internet operations, Matt replied, "I may be 200 feet in the air working on a tower, and then working on servers and computers in the office—all in the same day. There's not really a routine, and that's what I like the most." Matt says keeping tabs on the co-op's over 70 Internet sites can be quite the challenge. "It's most challenging during storms when you may have outages, but making sure all of the equipment is communicating is a lot of work especially as we upgrade equipment."

The equipment being upgraded is for our 25 meg wireless Internet. Proxim, the next generation of wireless technology, is continually being deployed, and is capable of delivering information at 25,000,000 bits of information per second. In comparison, dial-up delivered information at a maximum of 56,000 bits a second, usually around 14,000 bits a second.
