A special kilowatt hour rate is also available from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. for charging. For around \$25 in electricity, a member could drive about a thousand miles.

Mr. Giffin also informed members that with their generosity, over \$450,000 was given to local schools and organizations through the Members' Fund.

Board President Robert A. Brown reported on economic development at the meeting. The cooperative is focused on helping retain area businesses and drive growth. For those looking to expand business, the cooperative assists with the USDA Rural Economic Development Loan and Grant program. Additionally, this fall will mark the beginning of the Morgan-Scott CEO program for area high school seniors. CEO stands for Creating Entrepreneurial Opportunities and teaches students how to run their own businesses.

In other business, the members, at the recommendation of the nominating committee, elected three incumbent board directors to serve new terms. Re-elected were Gary K. Clark, district one; James W. Freeman, district three; and Eric Lakin, district seven.
