Youth Tour 2012

We want to encourage high school students to learn more about government and their role in it ... and provide a select group of student leaders with a chance to get an up-close look at their government.

McDonough Power Cooperative is once again sponsoring its "Youth to Washington" and "Youth to Springfield" programs this spring. McDonough Power and its sister cooperatives across the state have sponsored these programs for over 50 years in an attempt to introduce students to government and the political process. Today, many "alumni" of these programs work in state or federal government or have gone on to serve as elected officials. Two retired members of the Illinois General Assembly are "alumni" of our programs.

McDonough Power will sponsor two sophomore or junior students from each high school in its service area on an all-expense paid bus trip to Springfield on Wednesday, March 28, 2012. During the day, students and their counterparts from other Illinois high schools will meet their elected senators and representatives at the Capitol and learn first-hand about the

workings of state government. In addition the students will tour the Supreme Court and other historic sites of Springfield during the day.

McDonough Power will also sponsor two of these students on a weeklong, all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. on June 15-22, 2012. During the week in the nation's capital the Illinois student contingent will hopefully meet with Senators Dick Durbin and Mark Kirk. The U.S. Representatives will meet with students for a luncheon while on Capitol Hill. **533B8A-266B**

The two "Youth to Washington" representatives will be selected from the contingent that tours Springfield on March 28. (The two students will be chosen from their written and verbal responses to judges who will interview student representatives the afternoon of the Springfield trip.)

McDonough Power works with area high school staff to select student leaders who are interested in government and the political process and would benefit from this program. If you are a junior or senior in high school (or know someone who might be interested), please contact your school guidance counselor before February 1 for more details.

Switch to energy-saving halogen incandescent lightbulbs to cut lighting energy use by 25 percent. These bulbs last three times longer than traditional incandescent bulbs and can easily be dimmed. Whenever a Co-op Connections cardholder — whether from McDonough Power or from one of the hundreds of Touchstone Energy co-ops across the country — shows the Co-op Connections card at a participating business, they receive a discount. Equally, those businesses benefit from increased customer visits by co-op members participating in the program. And it's easy to spot which local businesses are participating. Look for the Co-op Connections stickers in their windows, or simply log on to the McDonough

Power's Web site — www.mcdonough-power.com — and check out the list of participants.

Members of the co-op can also save at the pharmacy. There are over 48,000 chain and independent pharmacies in the program — including Wal-Mart, Walgreens and CVS to name a few. Showing the card when purchasing prescription medications can save you between 10 and 60 percent. Note that pharmacy discounts are not insurance, and are not intended as a substitute. So far this year, members of McDonough Power alone have saved almost \$6,500 at the pharmacy.


You might be thinking at this point — where is my card? Members who do not have a card or have misplaced it may stop by the cooperative office and request one. **6430C9-272C**


