

Wise Investments in Energy Efficiency

The economic uncertainty we're facing these days has many of us putting money into something we feel comfortable with: our homes. Making a few upgrades around the house generally pays big dividends. And when boosting energy efficiency is one of them, the decision becomes a no-brainer.

For any energy efficiency work made at your residence during the coming year, Uncle Sam will foot 30 percent of the bill - not a bad deal! Through the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act - better known as the stimulus bill - the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) offers a personal tax credit of up to \$1,500 for energy efficiency improvements made to existing homes during 2009 and 2010.

The credit covers 30 percent of the cost of adding insulation materials and exterior doors, windows, and roofs designed to help reduce a home's heat loss or gain. It also includes efficient central air conditioners, air-source heat pumps, hot water boilers, and biomass stoves.

For weatherization-related work the credit covers only the cost of materials. With heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems as well as biomass stoves, installation costs also count toward the credit. (5224D5-958A)

So how does the math work out? Say you spend \$1,000 on new insulation. You would get, in the form of a tax credit, \$300 back. If you spend \$3,000 to purchase a new HVAC system and have it installed, you'd have a \$900 tax credit to show for it.

To take advantage of the program, a home improvement must have taken



place after Feb. 17, 2009 (the day the stimulus bill was signed into law), and products must meet specific energy efficiency criteria. A few rules of thumb will help you determine those criteria.

For exterior windows and skylights, rely on the Energy Star label. For other efficiency upgrades, request what's called a "Manufacturer Certification Statement" that the product or component qualifies for the tax credit. Many manufacturers post these on their websites, but be sure to verify that the product does qualify before making a purchase. You can also visit www.irs.gov/recovery to review guidelines for eligible purchases.

Energy tax credits reduce taxes owed, dollar for dollar, and can be carried forward to following years. While they can help boost any refund you receive, you won't receive a check directly for the credit amount. You can file for energy tax credits using IRS Form 5695, with a total maximum value of \$1,500 for improvements made in 2009 and 2010.

Energy Audits are Here – Another Valuable Benefit

What is the latest and greatest benefit I have as a member of McDonough Power Cooperative? The cooperative is always seeking ways to improve the benefits that you have as a member of a cooperative. So, McDonough Power is teaming up with GreenUP Technology to provide certified energy audits to our members at a discount.

Currently there are two types of audits available, the Base Level Audit and the Mid Level Audit.

Base Level Energy Audit

Most energy audits are actually “Checklist” or “Walk-through” surveys. This style of investigation relies on observations in the home, but the inspector typically doesn’t use any tools to quantify a problem. This type of assessment will look visually at the HVAC system as well as the types of appliances and lighting in the home. This audit will consist of visual inspection as well as a written summary of findings and recommendations for the homeowner. This audit typically takes one hour to complete.

Mid Level Energy Audit

This energy audit is similar to the base level audit with the addition of Infrared (Thermal) Imaging to see more clearly the energy transfer of the exterior walls, ceiling and floors of the home. The infrared technology is used to specifically look at the window and door openings in a home as well as missing insulation in walls, ceilings and floors. In the event moisture problems exist in the home, the infrared technology is used to assess these areas as well. This audit is more detailed and takes approximately two to three hours to complete. Capital Credits Refunded

As announced at the 2009 Annual Meeting of Members, the board of directors of McDonough Power Cooperative voted to return capital credits to members who received service from 1979-1981. (527SG4-950B)

McDonough Power is a non-profit electric cooperative. The annual operating margins, or profits, are allocated to members receiving service during the year. Margins are based on patronage,

or usage, and are called capital credits. Capital credits are applied each year to individual capital credit accounts and remain on file until the board determines a general refund may be issued.

Past and current members who received electric service for the years 1979-1981 should have received refund checks in August. The Cooperative is attempting to locate former members (or possibly their heirs) who received electric

service during that time. The Cooperative does not have a valid address on these accounts.


