October is National Cooperative Month

This time of year we celebrate being a cooperative and we invite you celebrate your membership with us. Why? Because being a *member* of Menard Electric Cooperative is different from being a *customer* of a utility.

- Unlike investor-owned utilities, we aren't under any pressure to generate big profits for far-away stockholders. We invest any profits earned into our local business or return the excess (known as margins) back to you in the form of capital credits.
- Our Board of Directors is elected by and made up of members who live and work in this area; instead of seeking profits they seek to provide service that is safe and reliable while remaining affordable.
- Our goal of providing a valuable service to our local community is the same as it was when the cooperative was formed over 78 years ago; when men and women in rural areas banded together to create cooperatives to serve areas that investor-owned utilities were not interested in.
- Today, Menard Electric serves more than 10,700 meters across over 2,590 miles of line. Although we've grown a lot in 78 years, we still operate under the seven cooperative principles we were formed under (see below).

The Seven Guiding Cooperative Principles

- Voluntary and open membership
- Democratic member
- Member's economic participation
- Autonomy and independence
- Education, training and information
- Cooperation among cooperatives
- Concern for community









Co-op Facts

- 47,000 cooperative businesses operate in America, this includes everything from credit unions and agricultural groups to grocery stores and daycare.
- 42% of the nation's electric distribution lines are owned by cooperatives. They cover 75% of our country's land mass.
- 12% of the nation's electric meters are part of rural electric cooperatives.
- 24 electric distribution cooperatives serve more than 294,000 homes and businesses in Illinois.

Safety Accreditation

enard Electric Cooperatives 👤 sets a high standard of safety for our employees and our members. We strive to provide our employees with the tools they need to work as safely as possible. We also seek to educate members in ways to stay safe around electricity as well as performing work such as tree trimming that helps protect all of our members and the general public.

Our commitment to safety goes beyond what is required and we have once again earned our Safety Accreditation through the Rural Electric Safety Accreditation Program (RESAP) sponsored by the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA).

This accreditation is earned every

three years after an intense review of our safety record, policies and procedures as well as performance of an extensive onsite field observation. The RESAP program measures the effectiveness of our co-op's comprehensive safety program and the standards used exceed those required by OSHA.

"Achieving this accreditation is a great accomplishment for all of our employees," says Manager Eric Hobbie. "It shows that we as a co-op are doing all we can to keep our members safe and to provide our employees a safe work environment and the training they need to return home to their families at the end of each day. Additionally, it saves our co-op money annually by reducing our insurance premiums."



Equity as of the end of June was 37.39% and the number of member accounts served was 10,791 compared to 10,756 a year ago. Net Utility Plant at the end of June was \$43,401,866 compared to \$42,342,125 last year. The cooperative continues to meet the requirements of the RUS, FFB and NRUCFC.
