

Once the app is downloaded on the phone and opened, it will ask you to login or sign up. If you currently pay your bill online, you will be able to use the same login and password. If you have not registered online, tap sign up. This will only take a minute. Members will need their member number, account number, and an email address to complete this process. If you're not sure of your member and account number, it is displayed on your monthly statement.

The app was designed to be quick and easy-to-use. Members will find the navigation and function of the app to be straightforward. IEC Connect is now available in the app stores for both Android and iPhone. If you have any questions about the app, please give us a call at 1-800-468-4732.





Youth Day 2018 will be held on April 18, 2018. Attention High School Juniors: Apply Now for CEO

CEO is now accepting applicants for the fall 2018 class. Students who will be entering their senior year this fall may apply.

Along with high school and college credit, students in the Pike CEO, Morgan-Scott CEO and Greene-Calhoun CEO Programs will be elgible for \$5,000 in scholarships awarded to each of the three programs.

The CEO programs take high school seniors out of their schools and meet in business settings throughout the year. Fifty to sixty leaders of the business, agricultural and professional communities make presentations to the groups, and the classes visit a like number of businesses throughout each year.

In the first half of the school year, the classes develop a class business which helps fund their individual businesses in the second half of the year.


