cludes prescription savings and discounts on vision, dental, hearing, lab imaging, and chiropractic care. But now you can also get 2-for-1 restaurant deals, discounted movie and event tickets, national partner deals, hotel discounts, cashback online shopping, and savings tracking.



IMPROVED CO-OP CONNECTIONS GIVES YOU NEW WAYS TO SAVE

he Co-op Connections program that you know and love is now better than ever. This member-benefit program gives Rock Energy Cooperative members access to thousands of deals. Here are some questions you might have about the program.

How am I able to receive discounts with the **Co-op Connections program?**

You are able to start saving immediately if you have access to a computer or smart phone. Simply visit www.connections. coop/Rock and create an account to start saving today. Then download the free Co-op Connections app from the Google Play or Apple app stores to your smartphone. You'll have access to thousands of deals right at your fingertips.

What should I do if I had an account on the old www.connections.coop site?

If you had an account on the old www.connections.coop site, please click Member Access at the top right-hand corner and log in with your email. Enter touchstone123 as the password. Once you've logged in to the site, we will direct you to change your password.

Can I still use my plastic Co-op Connections Card? Can I still get cards at Rock Energy?

Yes, your card will still work at pharmacies. You may pick up a card at our offices. Just be aware that you have access to more deals and features if you use the online and mobile aspects of the program.

What kinds of deals do I receive with this program?

You can use your card at more than 60,000 pharmacies nationwide to get discounts on your prescription medicine. We also have set up money-saving discounts at businesses throughout the nation.

What are some features of the upgraded **Co-op Connections program?**

The upgraded program allows you to view participating businesses through the mobile app, use coupons straight from your phone or computer, and receive deals from lots of businesses. We also have deals at theme parks, shows, events, and movie theaters.

Can I use this app while I'm traveling to receive discounts in other locations?

Yes. The mobile app maximizes member benefits by going beyond the card. You can take your savings with you wherever you go. Just set the app to allow location access and you'll see all the nearby deals.


I don't have Internet access or a smartphone. Can I still get these discounts?


NATURAL GAS RATES WILL CHANGE OCT. 1

The Rock Energy Cooperative Board of Directors voted at its May meeting to modify natural gas rates effective Oct. 1, 2018.

The following chart indicates changes to the monthly facility charge and the delivery charge per therm for the average residential member. The adjustment will amount to an increase of \$2.97 on the average monthly natural gas bill.

The is the first adjustment in natural gas rates since Rock Energy started providing service to the area in 2007.

Monthly Facility Charge	\$7.00	\$9.00
Per Therm Delivery Charge	\$0.18	\$0.19
Average Residential Monthly Bill	\$63.20	\$66.17



Installation of new meters will begin at the beginning of July in the South Beloit area marked "1" on the map and continue through the year in the order noted. You will receive a letter from us about four to six weeks before work will be done at your location. The new system will allow Rock Energy to respond to outages more quickly because the meter will notify us if you lose power. It also will result in a more reliable power distribution system, improved efficiency throughout the billing system, improved system power quality, and more usage data for members.
