

## Twelve scholarships of \$2,000 each will be awarded in 2019

welve scholarships of \$2,000 each will be awarded in 2019 through the Illinois Electric Cooperative (IEC) Memorial Scholarship Program.

Six scholarships will be awarded to students who are the sons or daughters of an Illinois electric cooperative member receiving service from the cooperative. A seventh scholarship, the Earl W. Struck Memorial Scholarship, will be awarded to a student who is the son or daughter of an Illinois electric cooperative employee or director. These seven scholarships can be used at any two year or four-year accredited college or university in the United States including vocational/technical schools. Four additional scholarships are reserved for students enrolling full-time at a two year Illinois community college who are the sons or daughters of Illinois electric cooperative members, employees or directors.

Candidates are judged on the basis of grade point average, college entrance exam scores, work and volunteer experience, school and civic activities, and a short essay that demonstrates their knowledge of electric cooperatives. All applications must be received by December 31, 2018.

The 12th annual scholarship, the "LaVern and Nola McEntire Lineworker's Scholarship," was awarded for the first time in 2011. This \$2,000 scholarship will help pay for costs to attend the lineworker's school conducted by the AIEC in conjunc-tion with Lincoln Land Community College in Springfield, Illinois. Sons and daughters of cooperative mem-bers; relatives of cooperative employ-ees or directors; individuals enrolled in the Lincoln Land lineworker's school; and individuals who have served or are serving in the armed forces

or National Guard are all eligible for the linework-er's scholarship. Applicants must have a high school diploma or a GED at the time the scholarship is awarded. This scholarship will be based on an essay, a biographical statement, references and a recommendation that will be submit-ted. The deadline for this scholarship is April 30, 2019.
