Pet proof your home by covering or enclosing electrical cords and taking steps to prevent other electrical hazards.

Although any pet can chew on a cord, recognize that puppies and kittens are the most likely pets to chew on electric cords. Use extra care with puppies and kittens in the house and be particularly careful not to have any electric cords near a puppy's crate.

If you see burns in or around your pet's mouth or notice shortness of breath or other respiratory issues, seek immediate medical attention for your pet.
