Be Prepared for Winter Weather

Stay warm – Have extra blankets on hand. Use safe, properly ventilated alternate heating sources; don't use gasoline, propane or natural gas burning devices indoors. **Stay fed** – Have several days' supply of food that doesn't need cooked, as well as 5 gallons of water per person.

Stay safe – Remember to keep a first aid kit, battery-powered radio, flashlights, and extra supplies of items needed for elderly, infant, disabled and pet family members. If you leave your home after a severe storm be alert for downed power lines.
