## Why does it take so long to restore my power?

It's spring storm season again, and with that comes power outages. Being out of power for an extended amount of time can try anyone's patience. Our dispatchers often get the question "how much longer?" Sometimes that is a very hard question to answer. First of all, we have a certain order of restoration we must follow in order to get the lights back on. Transmission lines provide our substations with power, which in turn is distributed to each of our members through a complex system of three phase, single phase, and secondary lines. We must ensure that the substation is energized, and all main feeder lines out of the station are clear of faults, before we attempt to repair the "smaller lines."

SIEC was organized in the late 1930s because the local investor owned utility did not believe it was feasible to extend its distribution lines into the rugged terrain of Southern Illinois, therefore we do not have the convenience of all of our poles being located along paved roads. A good percentage of our distribution system is through wooded areas, tilled fields and backyards. The line serving your house may be fine, but chances are it travels through a very isolated area before it reaches your home. Throw in a little spring time mud, downed trees, or even a creek that is out of its banks, and the restoration process slows to a crawl. Not to make excuses, but it seems most storms happen at night after the sun has set, so with the combination of darkness, weather, terrain and ground conditions, our linemen have their work cut out for them when a storm rolls through. **Janet Brown**

With all of that said, SIEC continually works to improve its



infrastructure, but unfortunately this is something that is not accomplished overnight. We currently maintain over 2,000 miles of poles and wire across southern Illinois. When we are tasked with providing new service to a member, or rebuilding a current distribution line, we always try to take into consideration the opportunity to make it accessible for future maintenance. Unfortunately, our maintenance needs and the landowner's requests don't always coincide. After the ice storms in 2008 and 2009 quite a few members asked the question, "isn't it about time to consider burying your lines like they do in the city?" That sounds like a great plan, but the cost of an underground line can be almost double the cost of an overhead line. Then you have to factor in the outage time. Although outages are usually minimal in new underground lines, it takes considerably more time to find the fault, and repair it. Unfortunately it is you the member that pays for

these system improvements, so SIEC makes every effort possible to be good stewards of our member's money.

So, when the next storm rolls through don't hesitate to give us a call to let us know if you have lost power, or to pass along some pertinent information that might help in the restoration process, but also have a little patience because all of our personnel are working very diligently to restore your power as safely and quickly as possible.
