Right now, it certainly seems to be a political pundit with the popular position being that of anticoal. I wonder, however, if the true merits of all the energy sources are being fairly evaluated? Why is it not reasonable for all sources of energy to be used? **SIMO** I **JPC** 

Coal has always been a part of southern Illinois history. If you and your family have made a living from it, you would say it has been a blessing as it has always been a big part of our local economy. Coal has also been part of the reason the rural members of southern Illinois have had plenty of affordable electricity available.

Providing affordable and

dependable electricity is becoming a huge challenge for the nation and Southern Illinois Electric Cooperative (SIEC). Presently, electricity seems to be readily available as there are adequate generating stations of various origins; but keeping it affordable in the future is questionable. Depending upon where you draw the line on some environmental concerns, you may feel coal should be replaced regardless of the cost. Others, however, may not share that feeling and thus the difference in our energy philosophies. While SIEC is involved with generation by hydro, wind, natural gas and coal through our power supplier, Southern Illinois Power Cooperative (SIPC) at the Lake of Egypt, and through solar and wind power projects from various interconnections with

our members, approximately 85 percent of the electricity in our members' homes is from coal-fired generation. Due to the fact that coal generation has been around so long, it is understandably the cheapest of all the sources.

We are very concerned about any pending or new regulations on existing coal-fired plants. The electric industry has historically complied with all environmental mandates, however costly. When you see the plume coming from the "smokestack" at SIPC, it isn't smoke at all but steam or vapor coming from the "steam-stack," which is a more accurate description of the process you are seeing. SIPC has made enormous investments and upgrades to keep their coal-fired plant clean and efficient. To comply with previous regulations, the majority of the investments and upgrades they began in 2003 have over \$100 million of useful life still remaining. Now, just 13 years later, regulators are not only wanting to change the mandates before the costs can be fully recovered, they are wanting to eliminate coal as a source for generating electricity. In doing so, they will increase the cost of electricity to levels not previously imagined.

I recently read where southern Illinois lost over 700 direct mining jobs in 2015 – 16 percent of the workforce – and another 600 jobs are predicted to be lost in 2016 as some of the largest coal mine operators close down or cut back. Alternative fuel sources like natural



Bennett For Outages Call: 800-762-1400 \* 618-827-3555 gas, wind and solar are great, but in terms of meeting our energy needs, they are not as affordable nor as reliable at this time as extensive investments would be required to generate and distribute enough electricity to serve all the meters coal-fired generating plants serve. The current infrastructure in place to generate and distribute coal-fired electricity across the country has taken many years to build and can't be replaced overnight. What is the plan for those periods when there is no wind, or the clouds form and rain falls for a few days? In the "polar vortex" winters of early 2014 and again in 2015, there was not enough natural gas available for SIPC to run their natural gas peaking units, let alone generate what they currently do with coal every day, rain or shine. If you know the laws of supply and demand, electricity will be priced at a premium when the supply is limited.

It's an election year so there are a lot of promises being made,

and many of them without regard to their cost or economic impact on rural Americans. Who doesn't want clean air or the environment protected? sanof sizmo We have to make reasonable and affordable decisions as they affect so many of us for years to come. Many of the individuals who tout these alternative sources are making great claims about the savings they will have by generating their own electricity through an alternative green source, but I'm not aware of anyone yet who has asked for their current electric meter and the lines that feed it to be removed. Affordable. Reliable. Reasonable. In terms of industry lingo, we need an "all-of-the-above" energy policy to help keep this nation and its people strong - we need to utilize all sources available and not shutter plants with useful life still in them.
