

The Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) has announced that Crosswalk Community Action Agency, headquartered in West Frankfort, will be administering the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) for Franklin, Jefferson and Williamson Counties. HEAP provides financial assistance to eligible households to help pay a portion of their

Energy assistance began in October 2023 and will run through August 15, 2024, or until funding is exhausted.

home energy services.

The 2024 Income Guideline for HEAP has been set at 200 percent of the federal poverty level. Eligibility is based upon gross income for the past 30-day period, beginning with the date of application, and is \$2,430 for a one-person household, \$3,287 for two-person households, \$4,143 for three-person households and \$5,000 for four-person households.


We are not taking "in person" applications. Go to crosswalkcaa.com to schedule a phone appointment for energy assistance.

Applications will be taken on a first come, first served basis. You will need to have the following documents ready to confirm eligibility with Crosswalk: Social Security numbers for all household members; proof of gross income for all household members for the past 30-day period; and a current heat and/ or electric bill.

You will have several options available to submit your documentation to Crosswalk (e-mail, fax, mail or our dropbox). This will be discussed when we call you at your appointment time.

If you have been **disconnected** from your utility, or if you are at or below 25 percent on a delivered fuel and cannot get a delivery on your own, you may qualify for Emergency Reconnection Assistance.
