During their visit, McDonough Power representatives met with Senator Dick Durbin, Senator Tammy Duckworth, U.S. Representative Mary Miller, and Nadia Cortez, Legislative Assistant to U.S. Representative Eric Sorensen. These meetings provided an important opportunity to discuss key legislative priorities impacting electric cooperatives, including FEMA reform, Rural Utilities Service (RUS) funding, permitting reform and other

policies that support reliable, affordable energy and strengthen rural communities.

At the heart of every conversation was McDonough Power’s ongoing commitment to its members — ensuring dependable service, advocating for rural America, and keeping the lights on.

By participating in the Legislative Conference, McDonough Power continues to make its members’ voices heard at the national level while working to protect the future of electric cooperatives and the communities they power.

Nominating Committee will meet

Members of the 2026 nominating committee have been appointed by the McDonough Power Cooperative board of directors. The committee will meet on June 4th at 6 p.m. at the Park Side in Macomb to nominate candidates for election to the board of directors at the 2026 annual meeting of members to be held September 2nd at The Crossing in Macomb.

District 4 — (composed of all Blandinsville, Sciota and Emmett townships in McDonough County): Matt Housewright, 301 Flint Road, Macomb; and Kris Stufflebeam, 15 Hickory Bow, Macomb.

District 6 — (composed of all Macomb, Walnut Grove, Bushnell and Prairie City townships in McDonough County and part of Lee in Fulton County): Harlan T. Baker, 13195 N. 2300th Road, Good Hope; and Tim Piper, 15401 E. 1750th St., Macomb.

District 9 — (composed of Kelly, Coldbrook, Floyd and Berwick townships in Warren County and parts of Galesburg, Cedar and Indian Point townships in Knox County): John Johnson, 772 147th St., Avon; and Chester Stephens, 1505 90th Ave., Berwick.

The bylaws of the cooperative provide that nominations to the Board of Directors may be made by (1) the Nominating Committee or, (2) a petition signed by 15 or more active members. The petition must be received at the principal office of the cooperative at least 30 days before the annual meeting.

The terms of directors from districts 4, 6 and 9 expire this year. Directors presently serving on our Board of Directors are: District 1, Michael D. Cox; District 2, Bryson Bedwell; District 3, Walter Lewis; District 4, David Lueck; District 5, Ryan Litchfield; District 6, Jeffrey Moore; District 7, Steve Hall; District 8, Robert Dwyer; and District 9, Courtney Chandler. **8120SL334-864C**

It shall be the duty of the board to appoint, not less than 40 days nor more than 120 days before the date of a meeting of the members at which board members are to be elected, a committee on nominations consisting of two members from each district in which a director is to be elected. No member of the board may serve on such committee. The committee shall prepare and post at the principal office, at least 30 days before the meeting, a list of nominations for directors, which shall include at least

one or more candidates for each board position to be filled by the election. The secretary shall be responsible for mailing with the notice of the meeting or separately, but at least seven days before the date of the meeting, a statement of the number of board members to be elected and the names and addresses of the candidates nominated by the committee on nominations.

Any 15 or more members acting together may make other nominations by petition, and the secretary shall post such nominations at the same place where the list of nominations made by the committee is posted. Nominations made by petition, in order to be valid, must be received at the principal office of the cooperative at least 30 days before the meeting.

Any nomination by petition which meets the requirements of the bylaws shall set forth in the annual meeting notice as nominations made by petition and any such nominations shall appear on the official ballot.

Unclaimed capital credits: We need your help

The Board of Directors of McDonough Power Cooperative has approved the return of capital credits to members who received electric service during 2004-2005.

As a not-for-profit electric cooperative, McDonough Power operates at cost. Any margins (revenues remaining after expenses) are allocated to members based on their electric usage for that year. These allocations are called capital credits and are assigned to each member's individual capital credit account. Funds remain on file until the Board determines that a general retirement and refund can be made.

Refund checks were mailed in August to past and current members who received service during 2004-2005. The Cooperative is currently working to locate former members — or their heirs — for whom we do not have a valid mailing address. **4129A4-1122C**
